

Graduate Fellowship Opportunities Available!

The Department of Food, Agricultural and Biological Engineering (FABE) at Ohio State University offers opportunities to work with world-class researchers in the fields of food engineering, agricultural engineering and biological engineering. One of the greatest advantages to students in the department is their ability to tailor their programs to their specific areas of interest. The low faculty-to-student ratio of approximately 1-to-6 allows a great deal of personalized interaction.

FABE is offering graduate fellowship opportunity for qualified applicants. The preferred criteria for students interested in being considered for a fellowship is a GPA of 3.6 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent on another scale), 75th percentile average on the GRE exams for the verbal and quantitative components and a 4.0 on the analytical writing component.

Fellowship recipients will receive at least one year of monthly stipends plus payment of general/instructional fees including nonresident tuition and student health insurance premiums. Additional years of fellowships may be awarded for exceptional applicants.

After the conclusion of fellowship funding, financial assistance equal to the fellowship will be provided. To be considered for a fellowship, students must apply by December 21, 2009.
